



Overview

Please be advised that Improvement District No. 9 has commenced work on the Lake Louise Fire Hall (LLFH) project on Village Road (between the Mountaineer Lodge & the Lake Louise Sport & Recreation Centre). This project is being managed by Alberta Infrastructure, however inquiries and concerns can be sent locally to Improvement District No. 9.

It is the goal of ID9 to complete this vital project with as little nuisance and impact to the community, however with any project of this scale you may notice increased noise, construction zones, and traffic changes. ID9 is committed to continuing active communication with residents, stakeholders, and local organizations to mitigate concerns and ensure that the community is informed throughout the process. We will be providing regular updates, such as public announcements, open houses and presentations at Council Meetings, to inform stakeholders of project developments, allowing for a smoother integration of these initiatives into the community.



Timeline & Impacts

What has been done?

- *Contractors have completed tree removal and mulching all trees on site*
- *Contractors have moved all mulch off site and delivered to Lake Louise Waste Water Treatment plant*
- *Contractors are meeting with Parks Canada this afternoon to confirm work completed as per assessment requirements.*
- *Contractors are in the process of removing all vehicles from area. One piece of equipment will be on site until, early next week (March 3-4) when it will be picked up and removed off site.*

What is next?

- *Contractors will need to go back to the site at a later time to complete the grubbing component of the contract (due to the squirrel hibernation period). Preliminary discussions indicate no longer than 1 week will be necessary.*

Impacts

Change in Timeline - This is a draft schedule and is subject to change. Every effort will be made to stay on schedule, however unexpected issues may arise which could alter this timeline. In the event that there are changes, we will do our best to communicate them with you promptly.

Equipment Location - Demo/tree clearing equipment had remained on-site and will be removed as indicated above.

Noise - *Equipment noise levels have been experienced for the past 5 days during daylight hours.*

Parking & Access - Access to all roads will remain throughout the project.
