LAKE LOUISE FIRE HALL (LLFH) & LAKE LOUISE MULTI-UNIT RESIDENCE (LLMUR)



Overview

Please be advised that Alberta Infrastructure's contractor will begin **initial site mobilization activities on Monday, August 10, 2026**, at both the **Multi-Unit Residential (LLMUR) project site** located at **100 Hector Road** (the former Day Care site adjacent to the Lake Louise Medical Clinic) and the **Lake Louise Fire Hall (LLFH)** site, located between the Recreation Centre and the Mountaineer on Village Road. This project is being managed by Alberta Infrastructure; however, inquiries and concerns can be sent locally to Improvement District No. 9.

ID9 is committed to completing this important project while minimizing disruption to residents, businesses, and visitors. As work progresses, the community may experience increased construction activity, including noise, temporary work zones, and minor traffic adjustments. ID9 will continue to provide timely updates through public notices, Council presentations, and other communication channels as new information becomes available.



Timeline & Impacts

Initial Site Mobilization

Monday, August 10, 2026

Initial site mobilization activities will begin at both project sites and will include:

- Installation of site fencing
- Delivery and setup of temporary site facilities

Residents may notice:

- Construction crews and vehicles on site
- Installation of temporary fencing around work areas
- Placement of temporary site facilities
- Increased construction-related activity and noise in the immediate area

Details on excavation and groundbreaking activities are **will be shared soon**.

Activity will occur at both the Lake Louise Fire Hall and Multi-Unit Residential Building sites. Traffic impacts are expected to be minimal.
